

## Guide to Household Garbage Disposal in Kujukuri Town

<b>Combustible Garbage</b>	<b>Kujukuri Town Designated Red letter Yellow bags</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Food waste</li> <li>● Plasticbags</li> <li>● cloth</li> <li>● plasticware/bottles (detergent, shampoo and cooking oil containers, etc.)</li> <li>● styrofoam</li> <li>● CDs, DVDs, video tapes</li> <li>● leather (shoes, bags, etc.)</li> <li>● paper diapers (please remove filth)</li> <li>● twigs, leaves, etc</li> <li>● rubber</li> </ul>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the pick-up location by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <b>Please dry all garbage thoroughly.</b></li> <li>■ Please remove dirt and sand from dry twigs and leaves before disposing.</li> <li>■ Please cut hoses and other long articles into 1 meter lengths.</li> <li>■ Please remove the metal parts of plastic toys. (If you are unable to remove them, please dispose on a metal collection day).</li> </ul>
<b>Recycle Garbage Cans</b>	<b>Kujukuri Town Designated Red letter Clear bags</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Empty cans (canned food cans, snack cans, seaweed cans, tea cans, coffee cans, juice cans, beer cans, cooking oil cans, spray cans, cans of 18 liter drums, etc.)</li> </ul>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the pick-up location by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ <b>Please remove any remaining contents and wash bottles in water before disposing.</b></li> <li>■ <b>Please be sure to use and remove all gas from spray cans and gas cylinders. Open a hole once all gas has been expelled. (When piercing a hole in them, please be careful and do so in a well-ventilated place with no flames.)</b></li> <li>■ <b>Please remove caps and lids, and dispose of them with combustible garbage or metal.</b></li> <li>■ Please dispose of cans in a dedicated bag. Do not mix with other types of metal articles (hangers, lighters, etc.).</li> </ul>

<p>Recycle Garbage</p> <p>Bottles and Glass</p>	<p>Kujukuri Town Designated Blue letter Clear bags</p>	<p>●Empty bottles, glass, crockery (dishes, bowls, flowerpots, mirrors, etc.)</p>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the pick-up location by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Please remove any remaining contents and wash cans in water before disposing.</li> <li>■Sort and put out empty bottles and glass/porcelain in separate bags.</li> <li>■Please remove caps and lids, and dispose of them with combustible garbage or metal.</li> <li>■Please dispose of glass carefully so it does not break.</li> <li>■Please return returnable beer bottles and large glass bottles to the retailers as much as possible.</li> <li>■Wrap broken glass, etc.in paper. and mark it as “危険”(dangerous).Please don’t double bag</li> </ul>
<p>Recycle Garbage</p> <p>Metals</p>	<p>Kujukuri Town Designated Blue letter Clear bags</p>	<p>●spoons, metal pots, toasters, rice cookers, hot pots, etc. knife, charger cords, umbrella frames, wire, needles, iron scraps, metal hangers, metal lids, nails, metal hoses, etc.</p>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the pick-up location by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Make sure to cut the cords off of small home appliances, then cut the cord into 1m sections and tie them together when throwing them out (make sure to put the cord sections in the same bag as the appliance).</li> <li>■ Please place nails in a box or bag and clearly indicate 「くぎ」 before disposing.</li> <li>■Please pack cutlery, needles etc. safely, and clearly indicate 「危険」 before disposing. Please don’t double bag</li> <li>■ Please dispose of umbrella frames only. Dispose of cloth and vinyl separately, with combustible garbage.</li> <li>■Please remove the hose and mouth units from vacuum cleaners. If they are plastic, please dispose separately, with combustible garbage.</li> <li>■Please separate lighters into their metal and plastic parts. Remove any remaining gas and dispose of plastic parts separately, with combustible garbage.</li> </ul>

<p>Recycle Garbage</p> <p>Plastic (PET) Bottles</p>	<p>Kujukuri Town Designated Blue letter Clear bags</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>●PET bottles are plastic bottles with a special PET mark on the bottom. PET bottles can include soft drinks, sake/alcohol, soy sauce, mirin, vinegar, and dressings. Please check the bottom of the bottle.</li> </ul>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the garbage point by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Empty plastic bottles and rinse them out with water.</li> <li>■Please crush PET bottles to reduce their size.</li> <li>■Remove the label and attach the lid to the plastic bottle. (The label should be thrown out as combustible waste.)</li> <li>■Please dispose of plastic containers (shampoo, detergent containers, cooking oil containers) as combustibles.</li> </ul>
<p>Recycle Garbage</p> <p>Batteries</p>	<p>Any Clear bag in which the contents can be seen</p>	<p>Dry batteries, coin batteries, button batteries, rechargeable batteries, electronic cigarettes, shaving equipment</p>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the garbage point by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Please have Car batteries picked up by a dealer or request a disposal specialist to do so.</li> </ul> <p>Please insulate Dry batteries, coin batteries, button batteries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Batteries⇒recycling collection depot [Batteries section]</li> </ul>
<p>Recycle Garbage</p> <p>Mercury thermometers Fluorescent lights</p>	<p>Any Clear bag in which the contents can be seen</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>●Fluorescent lights, light bulbs, LEDs(which are considered metals if part of an integrated unit, however.), and mercury thermometers</li> </ul>	<p>Please be sure to take garbage to the garbage point by 8:00 AM on collection days</p> <p>If tying together, please use string or rope.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■Please do not use tape as it is difficult to remove without damaging articles.</li> <li>■Please dispose carefully so they do not break.</li> <li>■Please dispose of electronic-type thermometers in“ metal” garbage.</li> <li>■Mercury thermometers Fluorescent lights⇒ recycling collection depot [Mercury thermometers Fluorescent lights section]</li> </ul>

## Oversized Garbage
